



Calculator Policy for MCAP Mathematics Assessments

A grade/course appropriate calculator will be provided through the computer-based delivery system for the MCAP Mathematics Assessments for grades 3-8 and Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II on items that allow the use of a calculator.
