Purpose

The purpose of this document is to provide the information needed when importing Accommodations for students into ADAM.

Steps to Uploading Accommodations

In ADAM menu > Rostering > Users

- Select Students needing accommodations/accessibility features (filters can be used)
- Use kabob menu > Student Accommodation Upload
- Click to create template this will download the template
- DO NOT change any data in Column A-H
- Update necessary accommodations/accessibility features

Once the file is filled out then:

- Save as CSV
- Choose file and Upload File
