

Grade 4 AT Screen Reader Support Document (use with AT Screen Reader Practice Test)

When using a screen reader, words may sometimes be read with varying pronunciations. For example, within a passage set in this form, the word "live" is pronounced with both the long and short vowels. Pronunciation may also vary depending on student navigation using arrows versus using tabs. While reading and listening, if you hear an incorrect word or a word that you don't recognize, try navigating a different way, listening to the word one letter at a time, or using your screen reader's spell word command to have it spelled for you.
